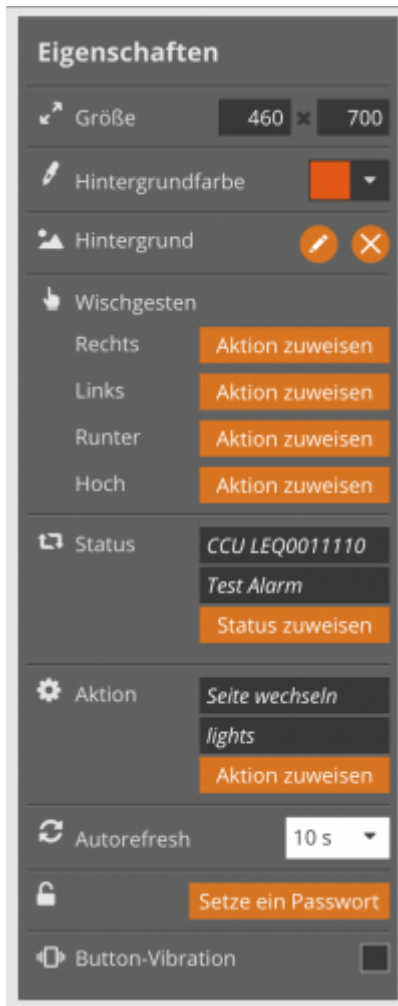


Page Status Action



Similar to buttons it is possible assign a status to a page and additionally an expected target value. Click on a free space on the remote page and then in the settings panel to the right on “Assign Status”.

If the requested status is received, an also assignable action is performed – e.g. a page switch or device command.

However, the status request will be performed normally together with all other status requests for the buttons etc. Which means, you either have to trigger a “Page refresh” action or have to set an autorefresh for the page, if the status request should be performed more regularly.

Important: The action will be performed each time the set status value is received. If, for example, the autorefresh is set to 2 seconds and the status value stays the same, then every 2 seconds the set action will be triggered.
