

To enable the cloud access of the AIO GATEWAY V6, open the “Cloud access” tab in the ConfigTool NEO.

Note: The cloud access only works properly, if a password is set on the gateway. See [set password](#).

Check “Cloud” and click “Save”.

Important: The address of the server may **_not_** be changed.

Then click on “Setup”. Access to the cloud is now set up and activated.

The cloud access can be tested by clicking on “Test”.

If the test is successful, a message appears stating that the gateway is reachable and how long the

request took.
